Respect each other

- ❖ If anyone is ill or injured, report it immediately to an adult chaperone so prompt treatment may be given.
- ❖ Turn off or silence your cell phone during the event as to not interrupt anyone's experience.

- ❖ Be good stewards of the building equipment, furniture and environment.
